Target Talk—June 2016

Attention Please! A member discussed a problem with me that he recently encountered on the high power range. He arrived to shoot, and found people were in front shooting prone and they did not move when he arrived. There are several problems with this: These people were inconsiderate in not immediately moving when he arrived, particularly since they were in clear violation of the posted rule, which is: **No shooting beyond the red line unless it is in a sponsored event.** Because you are practicing for a match does not give you the right to break club rules. Shooting beyond the red line is unsafe and you are creating a potential liability for the club.

The solution to this is to practice in front of the red line as though in competition *only* when other members are not using the benches, and if others arrive to use the benches on the high power range, show courtesy by immediately moving behind the red line. We all need to work together in this matter so that the Board of Directors does not have to become involved.
