Target Talk—September 2016

Very Important Notice!

We have an ongoing problem in the indoor range that we must address. Club members need to be aware that a large number of stray bullets are hitting the sidewalls on the range. The last seven to eight yards of the walls up to the target area of the range are being shot to pieces by what appears to be a large caliber firearm. These stray bullets are going through the soundproofing, hitting the concrete walls and ricocheting back into the range. They are also hitting the steel plates (baffles) up above, which are there to protect the lights.

Perhaps novice shooters are shooting from too far back, cannot properly control their guns and as a result are spraying bullets all over. This is a dangerous situation as well as one that is creating a lot of damage in the range itself. New shooters, please do not shoot from the 25 yard line. Wait until you have more experience and can better control your gun.

A Second Reminder

Club Members, remember if you bring guests with you to the range, *you are responsible* for their safety, conduct and adherence to gun club rules. *Your guests must remain with you at all times.* If you are shooting on the 100-yard range, your guests cannot be shooting on the 25 or 50-yard range – they must be with you! This club rule has been addressed before, but the problem still regularly occurs. Follow the rules and do not risk reprimand or losing your club membership over this.
